Agencies should be more aware of existing actions in FEMA required local hazard mitigation plans (LHMPs), that community contacts wrote up.

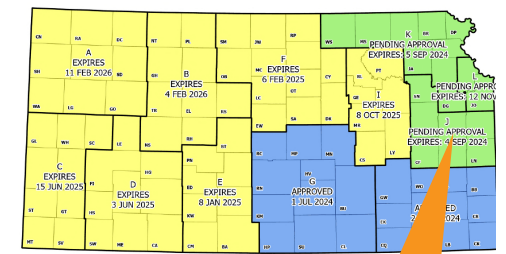
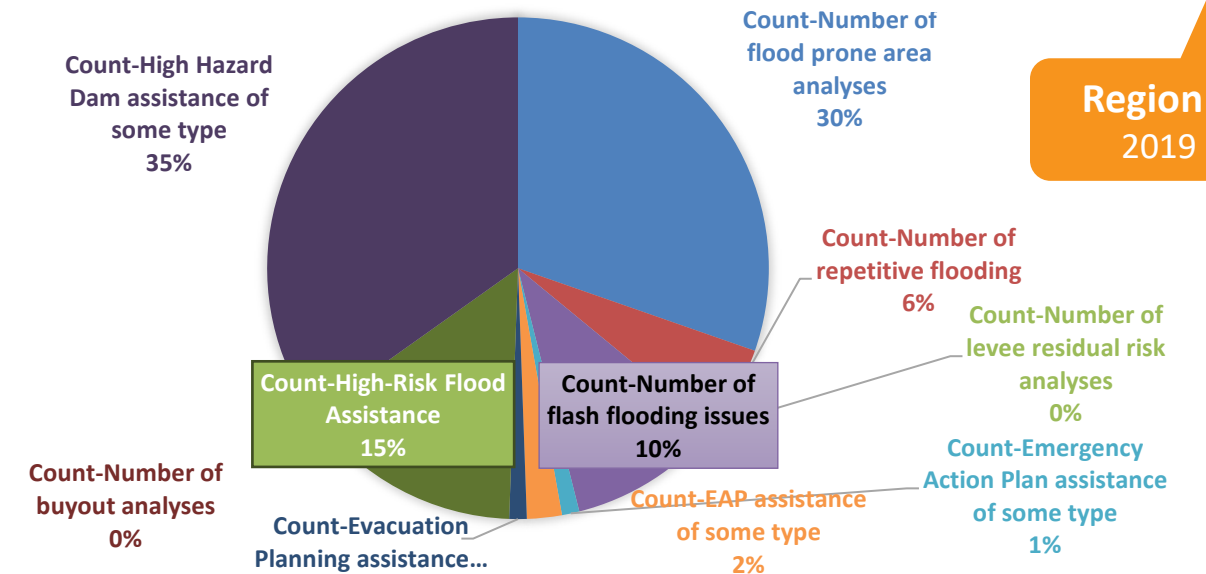
Kansas Silver Jackets assembled a spreadsheet
